

"Good evening and welcome to the D.C.A.R.C. Thursday night 8:00 net on the Daviess County Emergency Management Agency repeater."

"This is *[your call]*, my name is *[your name]* and I am located in *[location]*."

"This net will now break for any emergency or priority traffic."

[Should there be any, make certain to copy location, type of emergency, and if there have been any actions taken thus far]

"Bulletins, announcements, and other formal traffic will be taken in the first half of the net. The second part of the net will be an informal session and comments from each station are invited."

"We invite all stations to stay with us for the entire net, but any station required to leave early may do so by designating they are on 'short time' when checking in."

"Mobile or portable stations only, please call now."

[Acknowledge each station you hear by stating their call sign followed by "any others?" or similar phrasing. Make sure to copy each station's call sign for the check-in list.]

"We will now take check-ins from any and all other stations."

[Acknowledge each station you hear by stating their call sign followed by "any others?" or similar phrasing. Make sure to copy each station's call sign for the check-in list.]

"OK, now any station that we missed wishing to check in to the D.C.A.R.C. net, please call now."

[Acknowledge each station you hear by stating their call sign followed by "any others?" or similar phrasing. Make sure to copy each station's call sign for the check-in list.]

"We will now take stations with Bulletins or Announcements for the formal part of the net."

[Stations will give their call on the air. Copy their call sign onto paper so you can go back and ask each station that called for their formal traffic. Make note of the traffic for the logs]

"This is *[your call]*, net control station for the D.C.A.R.C. Thursday night net. Do we have any other bulletins, announcements or other traffic for the formal part of the net?"

[Stations will give their call on the air. Copy their call sign onto paper so you can go back and ask each station that called for their formal traffic.]

"With no further formal business for the net, we will now move to the informal part of the net."

[Call each station on the check-in list not on short time. If they check in "no traffic" it means that a station has no formal written traffic to pass; not that they are short time.]

"Are there any additional check-ins for the D.C.A.R.C net?"

[Acknowledge each station you get listed and give them a turn for informal comments]

"Is there anything else for the tonight's net?"
